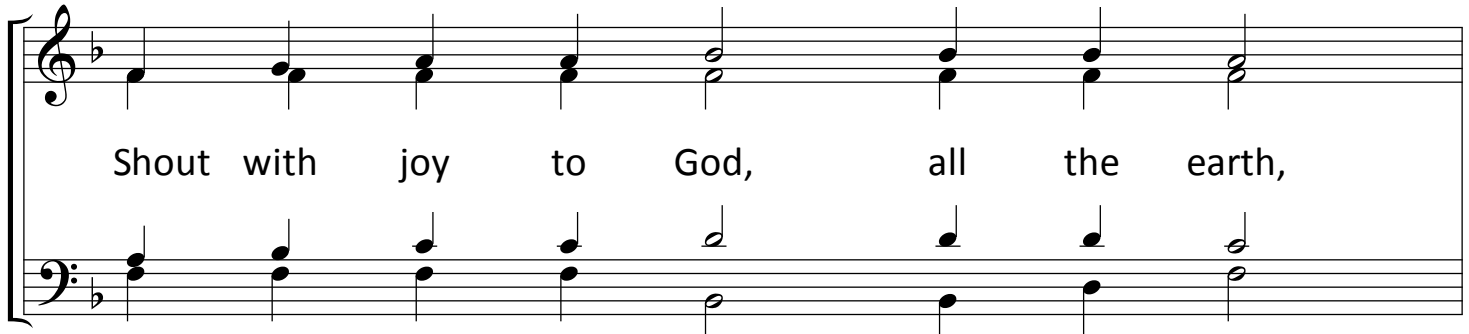


First Antiphon
