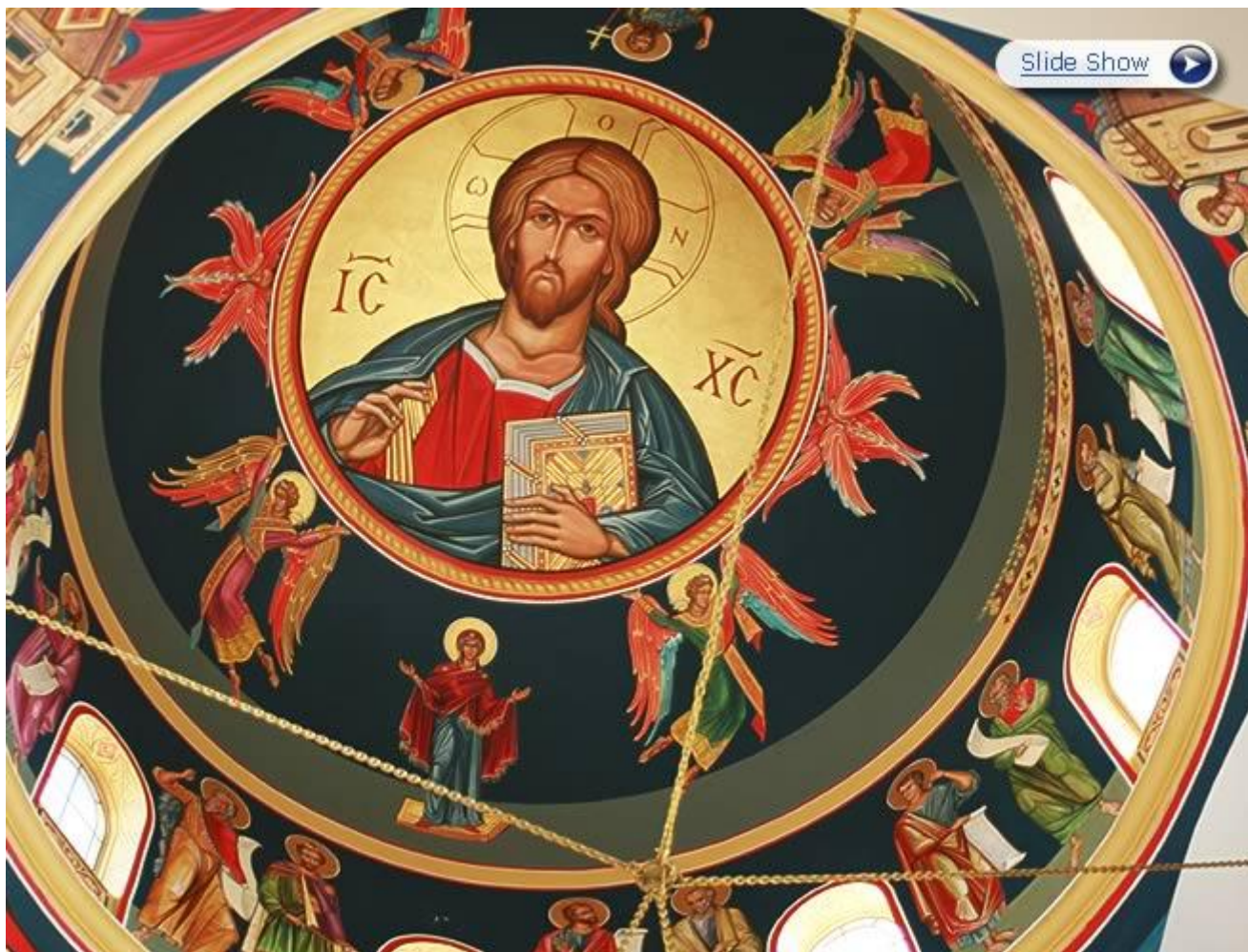

9. Great Doxology

Glo - ry to God in the high - est, and on earth peace,
